This year is going to be bigger and better than last year. We will be getting better schedule times, and the course is looking absolutely awesome. Apart from the riding, , this year's line up absolutely smashes it. Entry

You may arrive on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July to set-up camp. You MUST be at the venue by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July at 10am or you will have to buy a ticket.

Best Trick  
Vert

You will receive free entry into the event, and camping in the athletes area. If you would like to bring your girlfriend you must let us know BEFORE 15<sup>th</sup> May 2009. Your girlfriend will be entitled to a discounted ticket. Under no circumstances will they or any other competitors be allowed free entry. Only yourself and your girlfriend can camp in the athletes area. ANY friends who wish to attend MUST buy a ticket from HERE. They will not be allowed to camp in the athlete's area.

### Accommodation

The cheapest way will be to bring (or buy) a tent.

Or, if you are a true bling master, we will be co-ordinating the hire of caravans. If you wish to do this, please contact Jay Nowman, and we'll work out a discount price.

### Travel

There are two cities you can fly to. If you want to just head to the festival and then back home, Bristol is the nearest international airport. If you want to come and hang out in London before the event (please try and do this before, as we will be absolutely knackered after) then fly to any of London's major airports.

### Contest

There will be 3 disciplines this year: Street  
Best Trick  
Vert.

### Street

Riders will get 2x 1 minute runs plus time for a last trick. Their best score will count. Only in an event of a tie will your second highest score be counted.

### Vert

Riders will get 3 runs that can be a maximum of 75 seconds each. The run is over when the rider stops, falls or the timer runs out. The best run score counts. Only in an event of a tie will your second highest score be counted.

## Best Trick

This will take place on the Street course. The rider must make it known to the Judges and MC their starting position 1 rider before their turn. This will ensure a quick turnaround and keep the crowd hyped.

Each rider will get 3 tries. No points will be awarded if you slam. Your best score counts. Only in an event of a tie will your second highest score be counted.

So please confirm if you WILL or WILL NOT attend by 30<sup>th</sup> MAY 2009. Let's kill it again this year. See you there – Jay Nowman.
